

MERLINDALE BRIDGE / B712 ROAD CLOSURE  
3rd Sept to 17th Sept 2019  
Public Transport Arrangements

Border Buses have confirmed that the 91 service (Biggar to Peebles and return) will still run during the duration of the road closure but with the changes shown below.

**PASSENGERS WHO WILL BE AFFECTED**

Passengers who live on the bus route between Broughton School, Rachan, Drumelzier, Dawyck, Stobo and up to the A72 at Lyne Station will need to contact BARC Travel on 01721 721212 to arrange a taxi. The taxi MUST be booked a minimum of one hour before; there is no charge for the taxi. The taxi will collect the passenger(s) and then go to the nearest appropriate bus stop on the amended route.

People travelling on a bus who need to get to locations along the affected route will also need to book a taxi - same rules apply.

Passengers living outwith the affected route shown above won't be affected other than the bus re-routing from Broughton via Blyth Bridge and the A72 and vice versa for the return trip. Note that this may add some minutes to the expected arrival time at your destination.

School pupils who are affected will be given specific information from SBC about their alternative arrangements.
